Having found her true vocation, she began planning and saving and finally planted her own vineyard in 2008 at the tender age of 28. Her first vintage of sparkling rosé. Flavours of crushed soft fruit & summer pudding.	
Higher Plot - 2018 / Smith & Evans / DT6	12 65
A blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier & Chardonnay grown on limestone soils overlooking the Somerset levels. Guy Smith & Laura Evans (winemakers) believe this is the best wine they have made so far! The blend is 85% 2017 and 15% from their reserve which is made up of wines going right back to 2010. Has a great brioche nose as well as maintaining a fresh youthful profile. It is a dry wine although you wouldn't necessarily notice as there is rich ripe fruit on the palate and some beautiful citrus lemon aromas.	
Classic Cuvée 'Jubilate' – 2017 / Aldwick Estate / BS40 5AL 60% Pinot Noir - 40% Seyval Blanc. Jubilate is a nod to the Romans who introduced the art of drinking wine to the English. The name comes from the Latin verb "iūbilāre", which means to "Be joyful - all of you." It's a delicious, traditional method and fruit-forward sparkling wine made from Aldwick's estate-grown fruit in the Mendips, an area of outstanding natural beauty just at the lower tip of the Cotswolds in the west of England. Perfect for celebrations, or as an everyday treat!	58
Fine English Brut – N.V / Digby / BN18 9AJ	62

A luxurious, vanilla cream and fine pastry nose, with flavours of fresh wild strawberry, toasted brioche and a smooth elegant finish.	
Rosé Extra Brut – 2019 / Busi-Jacobsohn / TN3 9HX	70
78% Pinot Noir + 22% Pinot Meunier. East Sussex's Busi-Jacobsohn's family-owned vineyard makes vintage-specific English sparkling wines to best reflect the growing seasons and individual characters of each vintage. This 'Extra Brut' sparkling rosé has a lower dosage than most, setting off the crisp berry fruit with wonderful spice and refreshing acidity.	
Sparkling Red - 2021 / Dunleavy / BA4 6SX	50
