This wine is produced using the Charmat or tank method (the same method as used for Prosecco) resulting in a refreshing and accessible style due to the shorter period of ageing on the lees. London Clay is a modern and contemporary brand, located in the Crouch Valley in Essex, and established in 2019. The name pays homage to the unique fossil rich soil that is found across Essex and which gives these wines their distinct minerality and freshness.

A refreshing sparkling wine made from estate grown Chardonnay and Pinot Noir and filled with zesty citrus and green fruit flavours

Rosé – 2022 / Dunleavy Vineyards / BS40 5RS

Mix of Seyval Blanc & Regent grapes. Dunleavy Vineyards were planted by owner and manager Ingrid Bates. Ingrid has a background in biology and, after a short stint working in the media, began her viticultural career 20 years ago when she took up a job maintaining a local vineyard. Having found her true vocation, she began planning and saving and finally planted her own vineyard in 2008 at the tender age of 28. Her first vintage of sparkling rosé. Flavours of crushed soft fruit & summer pudding.

Higher Plot - 2018 / Smith & Evans / DT6

A blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier & Chardonnay grown on limestone soils overlooking the Somerset levels. Guy Smith & Laura Evans (winemakers) believe this is the best wine they have made so far! The blend is 85% 2017 and 15% from their reserve which is made up of wines going right back to 2010. Has a great brioche nose as well as maintaining a fresh youthful profile. It is a dry wine although you wouldn't necessarily notice as there is rich ripe fruit on the palate and some beautiful citrus lemon aromas.

Classic Cuvée 'Jubilate' – 2017 / Aldwick Estate / BS40 5AL

60% Pinot Noir - 40% Seyval Blanc. Jubilate is a nod to the Romans who introduced the art of drinking wine to the English. The name comes from the Latin verb "iubilare", which means to "Be joyful - all of you." It's a delicious, traditional method and fruit-forward sparkling wine made from Aldwick's estate-grown fruit in the Mendips, an area of outstanding natural beauty just at the lower tip of the Cotswolds in the west of England. Perfect for celebrations, or as an everyday treat!

Fine English Brut – N.V / Digby / BN18 9AJ

Vibrant yet understated, this fizz is in its element at home on a Tuesday evening or at a party celebrating one of life's big moments. An engaging expression of Digby's house style, it stems from England's most luscious Pinot Noir with rich, aged Chardonnay and plummy Pinot Meunier.

Blanc de Blancs – 2016 / Nyetimber / RH20 2HH

100% Chardonnay. For over 35 years, Nyetimber has had a single aim: to make the finest English sparkling wine, one to rival the best in the world. A true pioneer, Nyetimber was the first to craft English sparkling wines exclusively from the three celebrated grape varieties and each bottle is made from 100% estate grown grapes. An elegant expression of citrus and floral characters in its youth, giving way to toasty brioche notes with age.

Blanc de Blancs – NV / Coates & Seely / RG28 7QT

100% Chardonnay. In 2008, two old friends, Nicholas Coates and Christian Seely, embarked on a quest. They had between them successful careers in finance and winemaking, an unshakeable belief, and a burning desire to make, one day, a sparkling wine to rival the best in the world. A decade later, their award-winning sparkling wines are listed in royal palaces, Michelin-starred restaurants, and iconic houses around the world. This Blanc de Blanc opens with green apple aromas layered with creamy, smoky notes through to a harmoniously balanced and wonderfully persistent palate.

Blanc de Noirs - 2020 / Simpsons 'Flint Fields' / CT4 6PB

100% Pinot Noir. Charles and Ruth Simpson have been making award-winning wines in the South of France since 2002. In 2012, attracted by the quality of the terroir and the opportunity to become part of one of the most dynamic wine producing regions in the world, they brought their expertise back to the UK, establishing Simpsons Wine Estate. A luxurious, vanilla cream and fine pastry nose, with flavours of fresh wild strawberry, toasted brioche and a smooth elegant finish.

Rosé Extra Brut – 2019 / Busi-Jacobsohn / TN3 9HX

78% Pinot Noir + 22% Pinot Meunier. East Sussex's Busi-Jacobsohn's family-owned vineyard makes vintage-specific English sparkling wines to best reflect the growing seasons and individual characters of each vintage. This 'Extra Brut' sparkling rosé has a lower dosage than most, setting off the crisp berry fruit with wonderful spice and refreshing acidity.

Sparkling Red - 2021 / Dunleavy / BA4 6SX

100% Regent. Something a bit different! The fourth in an innovative series of sparkling reds using different red grape varieties. Lightest coloured sparkling red yet. Every year there is natural variation in the colour of the pressed red grape juice and 2021 created something so light they decided to call it a 'pale red'. This wine has all the raspberries, cherries and plums but less of the rhubarb. We think you'll love it! Think of this as a west country Lambrusco!
